Canine:

Canine dentals do vary in pricing. We categorize them into Early, Moderate, or Advanced. This depends on the severity of the tartar build up. All extractions are extra. If a tooth has any issues we will extract it. Leaving a compromised tooth may cause issues in the future. After we clean the teeth we polish them. Making each tooth surface smooth. Your pet's breath will smell better and help make them feel more like themselves.

Feline:

Feline dentals may not get as bad as a dog's teeth can but they still have their own issues. Cats will stop eating when their mouths start to hurt or they don't chew their food, preferring to swallow it whole. This can make them vomit. We run the same procedure for cat dentals. We clean off all the tartar, extract any compromised teeth and polish them.

All dentals include Blood work, Anesthesia, Dental cleaning and polish.
